

A Note From Our Dramaturg

In the US, we struggle with the notion of immigration reform, bearing witness to the many faces on our borders in search of safety. In search of a home. According to the UN Refugee Agency, "there are nearly 26.4 million refugees [and] around half of whom are under the age of 18," taking the journey alone. In their attempt to flee gangs, violence, and conflict, they, in turn, are faced with a myriad of challenges and atrocities associated with their harrowing journey, including the struggle of belonging.

As a story of strength, collective loss, and humanity, Naomi Iizuka's Anon(ymous) explores notions of homelessness, blame, empathy, and abuse of power. She uses Homer's The Odyssey as inspiration to underscore the trials and tribulations of young refugees encountering unspeakable acts of cruelty and astonishing moments of beauty. Tracing the sacrificial voyage of Anon--presumably short for Anonymous--we witness a young man searching for safety and stability only to face confusion, uncertainty, and antagonism. This brilliantly written piece avoids pinpointing the specific place, location, or even war that he and his mother Nemasani is escaping. As a result of lizuka's purposeful omission and ambiguity, she reminds audiences, like yourself, of the many children, from various backgrounds and cultures who have had no choice other than making such an arduous journey.

Propelled by a blending of magical realism, humor, poetry, and movement, Anon(ymous) intentionally shifts the notion of home from merely a place to the memories that sustain and the loved ones who give us hope because home is where love is overflowing.

A Note From Our Director

In Anon(ymous) by Naomi lizuka, we meet people who escape wars and survive seas, seeking safety, who land in concrete jungles juxtaposed with vast deserts that hold unexpected dangers as well as new joys. Since last fall, our cast and crew have explored this world of neighbors amongst us who are both invisibilized and hyper-visibilized at the same time. Iizuka paints what it means to survive on imagination, listening, and memory.

Originally commissioned by the Children's Theatre Company in Minneapolis, MN, lizuka adapts Homer's epic poem The Odyssey into a family theatre experience. What happens when we land on unknown islands on the journey towards home? What way-stations will shelter us? How can our memories bridge the gaps in what we know about who we are? When our islands collide, how will we recognize the guides we can trust to shepherd our way? While our young protagonist faces these questions along a coming-of-age journey, they arise at every point in life. We hope this exploration resonates for you.


Hannah Loftus (STAGE MANAGER)


Naomi Laurent (zyclo's bird)
